

“Abuse Prevention and Response Protocol” Training for Individuals



This training gives learners the skills to recognize and report abuse and is intended for individuals receiving PDD supports and their guardians.

This training follows the PDD guidelines and standards for Abuse Prevention and Response Protocol .

Upon completion of this training, individuals and guardians will:

- Understand what they can do to prevent abuse
- Understand that prevention is the key to addressing abuse
- Understand the types of abuse
- Recognize indicators of abuse
- Understand their roles in regards to reporting abuse
- Know how and who to report abuse allegations to
- Know the process of reporting abuse allegations and what will happen after the report has happened
- Understand resources that are available in the prevention of abuse
