Albertan's Advocating for Change Together will be hosting the 2018 Self-Advocacy Summit (conference) at Deer Valley Meadows by Red Deer. This year the theme is "Listen. Learn. Take Action." The summit brings together self-advocates and allies from across the province. Registrations are now open if you would like to go. Please see below information to help you.

1. If you are paying by cheque or money order, please make all payments to SAIPA. Cash can be dropped off at the SAIPA office.
2. **ALL** registrations, money and membership forms **MUST** be dropped off at SAIPA. SAIPA will be sending the money, registration forms and membership forms to AACT.
3. There will be a bus that will transport people from Lethbridge to the camp. There will be more details closer to the date on bus pick up from Lethbridge.
4. Lunch is not provided on the way to Deer Valley Meadows, so if you need food you will need to bring it.
5. You will need to bring your own bedding such as pillows and sleeping bags. You will be sleeping in cabins with beds.
6. If you have any accessibility needs, please let us know on the registration forms so we can do our best to accommodate you.
7. Support staff must pay the registration form as well.
8. There will be a concession at the camp if you want to purchase snacks.
